The Poster painting by David Lord depicts Dan Gurney driving one of five FIA Cobra roadsters in the 1964 Targa Florio. The Targa, run annually since 1906 was 1,000 miles of rough terrain in Sicily.

The Cobras built up an early lead, but the drivers discovered that the road surface was tearing up suspensions. Dan Gurney and Jerry Grant (co-driver) took a second in the GT class and were awarded eighth place overall. The Ferrari behind was one of many types in the race that was won that year by a Porsche 904.
