The roar of the engines and the sensation of speed are vividly brought to life in David Lord's watercolor and oil paintings. With a combination of exacting realism and fluidness of style, he recreates the beauty of an individual machine or creates the drama of a moment in racing.

David Lord was born July 4, 1941, in Brewer, Maine. He received his formal training at the University of Hartford, Hartford, Connecticut, and the Art Center College of Design, Los Angeles, California, where he earned a Bachelor of Professional Arts in Industrial Design. He was an industrial designer with UniRoyal for four years and was owner of his own design firm for ten years.

Early in 1980, he focused his complete attention on fine art and began painting automotive and aircraft subject matter full time.

His paintings are in many fine private collections throughout the United States and Canada and also in corporate collections, including, Indiana Bell Telephone Company, South Bend, Indiana; American Fletcher National Bank, Indianapolis, Indiana; Monogram Model Corporation, Morton Grove, Illinois; Gilmore Enterprises.
