

# PADDOCK SPACE RESERVATION POLICY FOR 2008

## GENERAL RULES

- All applicants need to have **FIRM** plans to use the space for at least four (4) WHRRI Race Weekends. Reserving a space just in case you might need it is not the intent of this program and will be frowned upon.
- All applications, documents and fees must be received on or before April 9, 2008. **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- Those wishing to reserve multiple paddock spaces must document the number of cars that he or she owns and intends to enter in at least (4) WHRRI Race Weekends. Note: Preparing a vehicle for a friend or customer may or may not be considered a valid reason for reserving multiple spaces.
- The reservation fee is \$70 per space for the season (2<sup>nd</sup> space for a 2<sup>nd</sup> car with the same driver is \$30). **YOU MAY NOT RESERVE AN ADDITIONAL PADDOCK SPACE FOR A SUPPORT VEHICLE**
- Seventy-five (75) applicants will be awarded spaces by WHRRI Membership Number as long as they qualify for a renewal (see renewal rules below)
- The WHRRI Top Ten drivers from each season are automatically awarded a space for the following season, provided they apply (fees are still applicable) and intend to compete. These will be removed from the original pool of applicants.
- Those individuals who are awarded a reserved paddock space may not alter that space in any way, without the permission of the WHRRI Board of Directors.
- **All paddock reservations expire at 9:00 am on the Saturday of each race weekend. At this time anyone may occupy a reserved paddock space.**
- A copy of the reserved paddock listing will be available at the Timing and Scoring bulletin board to assist others in finding available spots.
- Paddock space reservations are valid for the WHRRI club race weekends only.
- The program administrator will make every reasonable effort to meet an individual's specific need when assigning which space(s) each person receives.
- The WHRRI Board of Directors may award additional spaces to members they feel are especially deserving of one.  
If a participant withdraws from the program at any time prior to the second race weekend, that space will be awarded to the next applicant in the pool. If a withdrawal comes after the second race weekend has taken place, the space will be open for the remainder of the season.

**Posting your spot as available at the [waterfordhills.com](http://waterfordhills.com) bulletin board is encouraged, if you won't be using your spot on a given weekend. A "spot xyz is available" will suffice. It will then be considered unreserved for that weekend, that is, first come, first serve.**

## RENEWALS

- In order to renew a paddock reservation for 2008 competitor must have used the spot as an entrant or driver a minimum of four (4) race weekends during the 2007 season. If extenuating circumstances exist you may petition the program administrator for a possible exception. A participant may withdraw from the program any time before the third race weekend of the season and retain his eligibility to reserve a space for the following season.
- The competitor who has reserved a space will have the right of first-refusal for that spot in the following year, provided that person meets all other requirements and is awarded a space in the original allocation. **Some people may be asked to change spaces if the Comp Board decides to adjust the paddock layout.**
