

# WATERFORD HILLS ROAD RACING, INC.

## SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS 2008

### A. GENERAL

1. Waterford Hills Road Racing Inc. (WHRRRI) racing events are held according to SCCA's General Competition Rules, as it pertains to Regional competitions, except where modified by the WHRRRI Rules & Regulations or these Supplemental Regulations. WHRRRI reserves the right to vary from the GCR where appropriate. Race officials have copies of the GCR for reference.
2. WHRRRI is an independent, all-volunteer organization dedicated to the spirit of amateur road racing. Drivers and other participants are expected to conduct themselves accordingly.

### B. VEHICLES

1. Vehicle eligibility and classification will be as described in section VI of the WHRRRI Rules & Regulations.
2. Local township ordinances and Court injunctions require WHRRRI to keep noise levels at the property line below 75 dB and require that **all** cars **MUST** have an operational commercially available muffler. Sound will be measured on the back straight, drivers left.
3. Exceeding the noise limit or loss of the muffler will result in a black flag.
4. If you have not raced at Waterford, please contact a current race official for advice about mufflers.
5. WHRRRI uses the AMB timing system. If necessary, competitors may rent a transponder from the club on a per-weekend basis.
6. Emergency practice may be available Sunday morning, although participation is contingent upon Chief Steward approval.

### C. ELIGIBILITY

1. WHRRRI events are open to drivers with the following competition licenses: WHRRRI novice or full; SCCA novice, regional, national or pro; CASC, Midwest Council and NASA. Other licenses may be acceptable, check with the Director of Licensing.
2. The Director of Licensing must approve any license labeled as "provisional".
3. WHRRRI reserves the right to refuse any entry.

### D. PADDOCK

1. Because of tight paddock space, each competitor is allowed **ONE** support vehicle. Other vehicles must be parked outside the paddock in designated areas. Support vehicles must display a vehicle pass. Any vehicle in the paddock without an appropriate pass will be removed.
2. No racecar engine may be run on OCSC grounds prior to **10:00 AM** or after **6:00 PM** due to local ordinances and Court injunctions. This includes Showroom Stock and Improved Touring cars that may be street legal.
3. No race vehicles may be driven on OCSC grounds except for ingress and egress.
4. The Speed Limit within OCSC grounds is 15 miles per hour and is **STRICTLY** enforced.
5. **The speed limit within the paddock is 5 miles per hour.** Race officials will penalize anyone exceeding this speed limit or driving irresponsibly in the paddock.
6. Consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock prior to the end of the last racing event is strictly prohibited at all times.
7. The paddock access road will be closed to pedestrian traffic any time vehicles are on the track.
8. Several paddock spaces are **RESERVED**. The reserved paddock spaces are marked on the asphalt with a painted R and are available only to the driver holding the reservation. If the person holding the reservation has not arrived by 9:00 AM Saturday the space is available to anyone. If you use a reserved space without permission you will be moved.
9. Entry into the paddock will not be allowed prior to 4:00 PM Friday of the race weekend.
10. Paddock space may not be "roped off" prior to 4:00 PM Friday of the race weekend. If roped off space is not claimed by 9:00 AM Saturday, ropes will be removed. No tent spikes of any kind will be allowed in the asphalt.

11. No golf carts, motorcycles, mini-bikes, ATVs, bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, etc. may be ridden in the paddock during events.
12. No unofficial vehicles are permitted on the track before or after racing.
13. Camping is permitted for competitors in the paddock on Friday and Saturday nights of race weekends. Additional camping outside of the paddock is available on a first-come first-served basis. Excessive noise, rude conduct, or behavior that disturbs others will result in loss of camping privileges. Please note: Township quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM.
14. The following radio frequencies are for official use only:  
461.61250, 463.38750 and 463.81250

**E. GRID, PIT LANE**

1. Pit Lane is the fenced area between the tower and the track.
2. False Grid is the area perpendicular to the pit lane marked with grid positions
3. No unauthorized personnel under the age of 18 or with any known medical condition, which may affect ones ability to perform crew duties, is allowed in the pits or any other hazardous area.

**F. REGISTRATION**

1. Registration for drivers and crew will be open during the following times (minimum):  
Friday: 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM  
Saturday: 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM
2. Guests of a driver may enter the paddock during the following hours if they present a prepaid guest entry pass:  
Saturday and Sunday: 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM
3. Guests of a driver may enter the paddock during the following hours if a Will-Call pass has been pre-arranged for them:  
Saturday and Sunday: 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM

**G. TECHNICAL INSPECTION AND IMPOUND**

1. Technical inspection will be open during the following times (minimum):  
Friday: 7:00 PM to 9:30 PM  
Saturday: 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM  
Sunday: 8:30 AM to 11:00 AM
2. The official scales are located at the tech/impound area and may be available for competitor's use upon request. Cars shall be pushed, not driven, onto scales.
3. **It is the driver's responsibility** to know whether or not to go to impound and where it is located. See section VII of the WHRRI Rules & Regulations for impound requirements.

**H. TROPHIES**

1. Waterford Hills shall distribute all awards at a trophy presentation to be held on Sunday evening following the completion of racing activity for the weekend.
2. Trophies will not be mailed. No trophies will be available until after final results are available.
3. See section IX of the WHRRI Rules & Regulations for trophy requirements.
